Recreation Department Policies

Registration- Members may register beginning on Monday, February 16th. Non-members may register beginning on Monday, February 23rd at an additional \$5 per program. Pre-registration and pre-payment is required for all programs, including FREE programs. You can register at our office or via our website: www.oobrec.com

Refunds- If we cancel a program, all fees will be returned to your account as an account credit. If you withdraw 1 week or more prior to the trip, you will be credited the full amount, unless it's a contracted program. If you cancel within 1 week to the trip, you will receive a full account credit **IF** we are able to fill your seat with someone else.

Program Locations- Unless otherwise stated, all programs and trips take place at and/or depart from the Recreation Department at The Ballpark. **Please arrive at least 10 minutes prior to departure time.**

Photography Clause- We love to share the fun we have! During our trips and programs, staff may take photos to post on our social media pages or use in future promotional materials (like this brochure). If you prefer not to be photographed or included, please let Kira know ahead of time--we totally understand!

Activity Level Guide



To help you choose the programs that are the best fit for you, we've added activity level indicators to each trip or program listing. Please use this guide when deciding which adventures to join us for!

Level 1--Easy Going

Minimal walking or activity. Most of the program is seated or stationary. Great for those who prefer a relaxed pace.

Level 2--Moderate

Some walking required--such as navigating museums, parks, or downtown areas. May include uneven surfaces or standing for short periods of time.

Level 3--Active

Extended periods of walking, standing, or stair climbing. Participants should be comfortable being on their feet for longer stretches.
